Women's Skill – 2004



As a prolific power bowler, Cindy Burditt was nominated in the Skill division. She has been a sanctioned bowler for 30 years and has consistently been listed in the “Top 20” average in the Oklahoma City area. Cindy has bowled several 700 Series and has Two 300 Games to her credit. Her highest League Average was 207 and highest Series is 743. Cindy has been on many teams that have won or placed in the City, State and National Tournaments. She has won All Events in Oklahoma City Women’s Championship Tournament and bowled on teams that placed 11th at Las Vegas and 7th at Tulsa in the WIBC’s National Championship. Louise Mackey, nominator, described Cindy as extremely personable, fun to be around, a very dedicated bowler, a good team member and league worker. Cindy has always bowled with a 16 pound bowling ball and when she got ready to go to the National or State Tournaments, she would have a new ball drilled at 16 pounds...no more or no less. Then she would take it to several pro shops and have it weighed to make sure all the scales agreed it was 16 pounds. One time at Sheridan Lanes in Tulsa, while bowling in the State tournament, she threw her ball, a perfect strike sending all but one pin to the back of the pit. One pin, however came flying back to her straight down the lane and stopped at the foul line. I think you’d call that “having something on the ball”. The Oklahoma City Bowling Council proudly inducts Cindy Burditt to its Hall of Fame.
