Laymond Crump was born March 20, 1917 in Braggs, Oklahoma. He began bowling in 1932 at Tulsa in church leagues, writing bowling columns for the Tulsa World and Tulsa Tribune from 1934 until coming to Oklahoma City with The Oklahoman & Times in 1946. He has been a bowling column writer for more than 25 years and edited bowling newspaper for several years in 1960's. He has literally written millions of words about bowling. He was founder of Honor Roll Tournament, Tournament of Champions of Oklahoma City as well as helped promote the Times Classic Tournament. He was President of the Oklahoma City Men's Bowling Association in 1952. Pinky Mccan says of Laymond Crump: "This man has done as much as anyone in Oklahoma for the promotion of bowling, not only in Oklahoma City, but as well as the rest of the region.
