
GLENN HAMILTON

Glenn Calvin Hamilton was born in Electra, Texas but has spent the past 30 years in the Oklahoma City area. He was a dedicated tournament bowler participating in all the major tournaments. He has held all offices in leagues, was tournament director and very knowledgeable on all rules. He has a pleasing personality and is neat in appearance. His top 5 league averages are: 206, 205, 204, 202 and 200. His high sanctioned series is 789 and high game is 300. Tournament wins include: Four States, Oklahoma City All Events, Oklahoma State All Events, Southwest All Events, The Hartman Tournament, Southwest Doubles (twice), Mersfelder 700 Club (three times). Being a member of the 700 Club he was twice elected OKC Bowler of the Year based on average & tournaments. He led the Masters League in 1962 in average, series and game. He bowled back to back 700's at Holiday Lanes in April 1962 (724 & 704). He averaged 222 for 16 Game Marathon on his way to 1st Place worth \$500, August 4, 1962 at Northeast Bowling Center. His high game was 260 and his low game was 195. For his bowling prowess and competitive spirit in league and tournament, the Oklahoma City Bowling Council inducts Glenn Hamilton into the Oklahoma City Bowling Hall of Fame.
