Along the way they had 3 children, Cory, Trey and Michael. They began with little money so Peggy and Jim had a lot of work to do. Jim worked the business aspect while Peggy promoted leagues. They retained several and started new tournaments and leagues such as: Walt Neal and Hazel Green Tournaments, PBA Regional, Southwest Regional Resident Pro Championship, OKC Association, Men's State, Southwest Annual, Civic League, Women Bankers and the Elks. Both Jim and Peggy are members of the OKC Bowling Proprietors Association and both have served as its President. Jim has been the Association representative on the Bowling Council for many years and Peggy has been on the Board of Directors for High School Bowling the past 4 years. It is because of their generosity and work with fellow proprietors within the BPA that High School Bowling is the fastest growing sport in America and youth bowling is on the upswing in OKC. They also bowl, Peggy sometimes 3 days a week and Jim once or twice a week. They participate in several of the local tournaments as well. Peggy has bowled in 18 National WIBC Tournaments, traveling with many of the Lady Delegates of the OKC Women's Association.
