J R Hudson, 70 was born in Altus, Oklahoma, moved to Yukon 53 years ago and began bowling at Bowling Green II in 1988. He has excelled in all phases of bowling, both service and skill. His first year of bowling ended with averages of 183 and 197. The next year he finished with 208 average and moved upward ever since. In 2012-13 he averaged 230 with 102 games bowled. He has finished in the "Top 20" average 7 years. He has bowled Seven 300 Games, Four 299 Games, Five 11-in-a-Row Games and bowled his High Series in 2010 of 824. He has maintained a Tournament Average of 218 with 1st Place in 2008 Sooner State Games and 2008 Senior Tournament. He is dedicated to the Sport and has attended many bowling clinics to improve his game, earning a Silver Level Coaching Certification in 2013. JR joined the Staff of 900 Global a year ago to further his technical knowledge of the sport and to help promote bowling. He has been a Collegiate Coach at Southwestern Christian University and at the University of Central Oklahoma. Currently, JR coaches the Piedmont High School. He was elected to the Greater Oklahoma City Area USBC Association Board of Directors in 2008 and promptly convinced the Association that Coaching Clinics were needed. He became the lead instructor and was instrumental in obtaining volunteers for on lane coaching. Under his guidance the Association has held over 30 clinics in different centers the past six years. For his service and outstanding dedication to the sport as well as his excellent bowling ability, the Oklahoma Hall of Fame proudly inducts J R Hudson into its Hall of Fame.
