Born January 1, 1951 in Yukon, Oklahoma, Keith has been a sanctioned bowler for 20 years. He has great appeal to all bowlers having worked with the youth leagues for two years and having been a league officer for 15 years. He is always promoting the sport of bowling while carrying league averages of: 224, 215, 214, 217, and 213. Keith has bowled eleven 300 Games and three 800 Series, high being 824. He also has two 299 games and two 298 games to his credit. His first 300 game was bowled at the 1989 ABC National Tournament as he was the first Oklahoman to achieve perfection at the national stage. He captured the Red Apple Singles title in 1983, the Generation Gap Tulsa title in 1990 and Oil Capitol All Events in 1979. Nominator Harwell Heare says about Keith: "I believe this bowler is one of the rare breeds that shows good sportsmanship ability, shares his talents to any bowler seeking help, including his opposition. There is no generation gap working with, bowling with, or against Keith." For his bowling ability and love for the sport, the Oklahoma City Bowling Council inducts Keith Selement into its Oklahoma City Bowling Hall of Fame.
