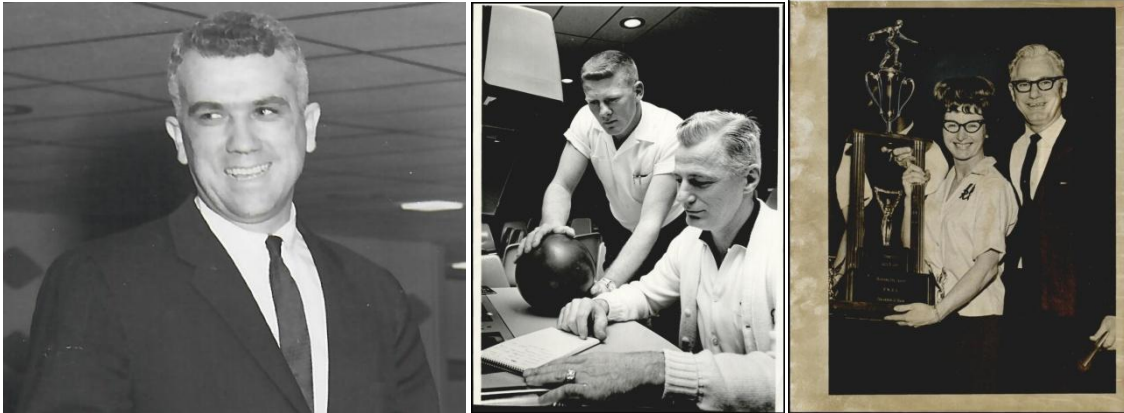


JAMES SOUTHERLAND

Born March 28, 1922 in Hamilton, Texas, Jim came to Oklahoma City 30 years ago and has been a sanctioned bowler for 20 years. He is described as a man that was liked by all people and was very out-going and considerate. He was a member of the National, State and City Bowling Proprietors Association, as founder, builder and owner of Windsor Lanes. He served as President of the OKC Bowling Proprietors Association 4 years, and State BPAA as well. He was promotion director of each for many years. He was the one of the founding members of the YBA State Program while at Windsor Lanes and had both sides of his bowling center filled every Saturday morning with future stars bowling every Saturday at 8am – bantam, prep, juniors and majors. Each youth developed and moved forward thru his programs. Jim was a great service to the bowling industry and the sport itself. Not a power bowler himself (hi 186 average) his legacy will live on through his children and grandchildren. For his innovative ideas and business knowledge, the Oklahoma City Bowling Council induct Jim Southerland into it's Oklahoma City Bowling Hall of Fame.
