Jeri was born in Casper, Wyoming and came to the Oklahoma City area in her early 20's, bowling here for the past 45 years as a sanctioned bowler. While in league, Jeri began amassing awards; most pins over average, WIBC watches, 100 pins over, etc. She also has honors in Pro-Am Qualifiers, Gold Medals in the Sooner State Games, NABI Championships and was on the Regional Championship Team in the Tournament of Champions. She has bowled Two 300 Games, Two 299 Games, Two 290 Games and many 700 Series, High being 771. IN 1991, for a span of 2 weeks, Jeri bowled four 700 Series. She received a Lifetime Achievement Award from WIBC for carrying a 200 average. Age certainly didn't slow Jeri, as a Senior Bowler she won 22 Gold and 3 Silver medals at the Pioneer Senior Olympics. She was deemed Bowler of the Week 15 times during league play and has carried a 200+ average for 6 years in a row. She has been in the "Top 20" average 7 times and is considered Oklahoma City Area's Top Senior Female bowler. A very dependable and loyal league bowler, Jeri is also dedicated and supportive to all league bowlers and to the league officers. Having been a league officer for many years, she is knowledgeable of Rules and Procedures and is always there to help. For her unwavering commitment to excellence and for her exceptional skill in the Sport of Bowling, the Oklahoma City Hall of Fame is proud to induct Jeri Taylor into its Hall of Fame.
