SEMI-FINAL: Consists of ONE 4 Game Block, total pins plus handicap for the top 40% of total entries in
QUALIFYING ROUND, Sunday, October 17th at 9:00 a.m.

FINAL: Consists of TWO-GAME ELIMINATION BRACKETS, total pins plus handicap,
for the top 16 BOWLERS from the SEMI-FINALS, the final bracket to
determine the winner - Sunday, October 17th, immediately following the semi-finals.

RULES AND INFORMATION

1. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO BOWL IN THE OKLAHOMA STATE USBC QUEENS TOURNAMENT, an Entrant MUST be a current member of the USBC and the OKLAHOMA STATE USBC.
 2. Entry Opening Date -- September 6, 2010.
 3. Entry Closing Date -- MIDNIGHT, OCTOBER 6, 2010 or when 160 entries have been received.
 4. 80% Handicap of Entrant's Average from 200. Any entrant with 150 average or under handicap will be figured from 150 average.
 5. Entrant's Highest USBC Yearbook Average of 21 games or more for the 2009-2010 season. If no USBC Yearbook Average, entrant shall use her highest USBC Summer League (2010) average of 21 or more games. If no USBC Summer League Average, she shall use her current USBC average of 21 games or more at time of bowling. ALL OTHERS BOWL SCRATCH.
- ENTRANT SHALL FURNISH AVERAGE VERIFICATION WITH ENTRY.
6. Rule 319a3 (average verification) does apply. Failure to report correct average will result in disqualification or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. Rule 319a2(ten pin rule), Rule 319d (prize winnings) and Rule 319e (tournament games) do not apply.
 7. ENTRY FEE is: \$60.00 per Entrant.
 8. PRIZE FUND will be returned 100%. Top 16 finalists will receive cash awards up to 160 entries, then one in ten. The first alternate will receive the amount indicated on the tentative prize list (usually the amount of the entry fee).
 9. FIRST ALTERNATE - The first alternate shall receive the amount set out on the tentative prize list (usually the amount of the entry fee). She must stay in the bowling center until all matches are finished in order to receive the prize money for the alternate. If she leaves, she forfeits this amount. Prize money for the alternate and the original finalist will be equally divided at the conclusion of the tournament if the alternate enters match play.
 10. Entries and entry fees to be mailed to: Oklahoma Queens Tournament, 32208 E 142nd St S, Coweta OK 74429.
 11. If an Entrant is unable to participate in the tournament, entry fee shall be forfeited. Bowlers who do not show up to bowl may be replaced with eligible bowlers on a first come basis. Tournament Manager will retain a list of replacement bowlers who will be used as needed. All replacements must pay the \$60.00 entry fee to the Oklahoma Queens Tournament.
 12. Bowlers MUST report ONE-HALF (1/2) HOUR before participating in the tournament on all squads.
 13. LANE ASSIGNMENTS AND ROTATION - Entrants shall be assigned lanes by computer. Lane rotation will be determined by the number of lanes being used. Bowlers will move lanes after each game of qualifying and semi-finals.
 14. 40 PERCENT - Lanes for the top 40 percent will be assigned by the tournament manager.
 15. 16 FINALISTS - Lanes for the top 16 finalists will be assigned by the tournament manager
 16. Bowlers may not use any foreign substance on their shoes. A violation of this rule could result in forfeiture of the games.
 17. USBC RULES will be observed at all times during the tournament.
 15. All rules are established for the welfare of the bowlers as a whole. We know you appreciate this fact and will cooperate fully so that all contestants will perform their best and enjoy this "48th ANNUAL OKLAHOMA USBC QUEENS TOURNAMENT".
