Senior Mixed Tournament Rules

1. Entry is open to all USBC members 55 and over as of Oct. 30, 2010 who are bowling in the state of Oklahoma. Tournament will be sanctioned by USBC. Card holding Professional Bowlers are not eligible to bowl in this tournament.
2. Tournament will consist of Mixed Doubles and Singles Events. Doubles will consist of 1 man and 1 woman; 2 men; or 2 women. Singles event will have two divisions – Men and Women. Handicap will be 75% from 200 for Men and 85% from 200 for Women. Bowlers may enter doubles more than once provided they change partners.
3. All-Events scores will be classified as follows:

Two Divisions – Men and Women

Class "A" - 75 years of age and over

Class "B" - 70 years of age thru 74 years of age

Class "C" - 65 years of age thru 69 years of age

Class "D" – 60 years of age thru 64 years of age

Class "E" – 55 years of age thru 59 years of age

Age classification will be based on the participant's age at the time of participation in the state competition. Proof of age will be required. There will be no fee for All Events, however, each bowler who has the greatest handicap score for his/her two events shall qualify for the National Senior Championship Tournament in 2010. The Oklahoma State Bowling Council will pay the entry fee of \$140.00 for each division and class to the National Senior Championship Tournament in 2010. (See Rule 7 for tie breaker.)

4. Entering Average Rule: Entrants must use their highest USBC sanctioned league average regardless of whether bowled as a regular member or substitute. Averages will be accepted in the following order:
 - A. Highest 09/10 Winter season average for at least 21 games. (Book average will be accepted as official.)
 - B. If Ruling A cannot be applied, the entrant shall use his/her highest 2010 Summer league average of 21 games or more in one league.
 - C. If Ruling A or B does not apply, a current sanctioned league average of nine or more games as of date of participation.
 - D. If none of the above apply, entrant must use the scratch figure of 200.
 - E. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler or others. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than the correct average, thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.

Corrections in averages can be made up to the completion of the first game bowled in the tournament, or within 48 hours after completion of the series if the tournament manager, prior to the completion of the first game, has given written consent to the bowler authorizing such extension of time to correct their average.

5. USBC rule 319a (2) - (10 pin increase provision) will be waived. USBC rule 319e will apply to USBC participants. All bowlers who qualified for a prize of \$600.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 months must report– actual score, position, and amount won for possible rerating. USBC rule 319d.
6. Prize fees will be returned to participants 100% in prizes. Prize Ratio - at least 1 prize for each 10 entries in each event.
7. In the event of first place ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. In the event of a tie for further competition (National Senior Championship Tournament), the high single game with handicap will be the tie breaker and, if needed, the second high game with handicap.
8. All winners averages will be verified before distribution of prize fund. It shall be the entrants responsibility to complete the entry form and indicate average ruling to be applied. The following information must be completed:

9. Bowlers need not belong to a Senior League to be eligible for entry in this tournament.
10. The tournament committee have the authority to decide any other matters pertaining to the operation of the tournament not covered by the above rules.
