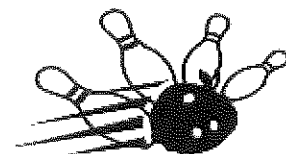
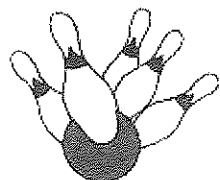

Tournament Format

Qualifying Format: All bowlers will bowl 6 games. Bowlers will move one pair to the right after each game. Position standings will be posted after the completion of the first 3-game block. After the 6 games, the field will be cut in half. Bowlers will then bowl 3 more games. After the 9 games, the field will be cut to the top five bowlers for the step ladder finals.

Stepladder Finals: Bowlers will be seeded 1-5 based on qualifying format scores. The 5th seed will bowl the 4th seed, and the winner would then bowl the 3rd seed, and down the line until a final winner has been determined. Stepladder matches will be 1-game single elimination matches. All matches that end with a tie, will be decided by 1 game roll-off.

Tournament Rules

- 1) USBC Rules and Regulations will govern the Tournament.
- 2) All participants are required to be a member in good standing of the USBC and have in their possession a current USBC card.
- 3) Handicap: **90% of 210. Maximum handicap is 25 pins per game.** It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of average. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to or at the time of bowling shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average.
- 4) The **Entering Average** of all bowlers shall be the highest sanctioned Fall-Winter League average (minimum 21 games) as of January 1, 2017. Bowlers without a sanctioned Fall-Winter average will use their highest book average (of 21 games or more) for the 2015-2016 season. Note: Sport bowling league averages must be adjusted according to USBC Rule 201a. Failure to comply will result in disqualification if adjusted average would be higher than the average used. **All others bowl scratch.** PBA members bowl Scratch. **All Averages will be verified using Bowl.com.** If not verifiable, you will bowl scratch.
- 5) USBC Rule 319-A-B-C-E (excluding 319 A-2) applies to all bowlers. Failure to comply shall cause forfeiture of all entry fee, scores, and prize money.
- 6) **Payoff Ratio:** Winner of the tournament will receive a **FREE ENTRY** into the next months tournament and \$1000*. (guaranteed with 50 bowlers)
- 7) Payout ratio is one prize awarded for each five entries.
- 8) Original scores sheets are official and any obvious errors are subject to change and correction by the Tournament Director.
- 9) In case of mechanical failure, contestants may be moved to the next available pair of lanes.
- 10) Offensive language, unsportsmanlike behavior, or destruction of bowling alley equipment will not be tolerated. Tournament Officials can disqualify any bowler for any of these reasons.
- 11) Stepladder Finals: Each participant will receive 5-minutes practice prior to the start of each match.
- 12) Dress Code: The dress code for the Tournament will be casual. (Shorts, Jeans, etc., are permitted). No offensive shirts (no inappropriate language, etc.,) will be allowed to be worn.
