RULES

Eligibility: This tournament will be open to all current USBC certified youth division bowlers within the OKC Area USBC Association. Unattached membership will be allowed and may be purchased on site for \$4.00.

Format: This will be a singles tournament only. All bowlers will bowl three games.

Entries: Entries must be postmarked no later than December 6, 2019. No entries will be accepted without all fees and standing sheet or average verification. Entries will be accepted by fax or in person by December 6, 2019.

Entry Fee: Entry fee will be \$25.00. Fees must accompany entry form. Fee Breakdown: Lineage \$7.25, \$17.75 to Scholarship Support. All other expenses will be paid by the Greater OKC USBC Bowling Association.

Averages: Each Entrant shall use their highest USBC Certified league average as found on bowl.com of 12 games or more for the 2018-2019 bowling season. If bowler does not have a 2018-2019 average or their current average of 12 games or more is 10 pins higher than 2018-2019 season, current average will be used. Bring current standing sheet. If averages were not reported for 2018-2019 a final standing sheet will need to be provided with entry. If bowler has no 2018-2019 or current average of 12 games or more as of Dec 14, 2019, bowler may use their highest summer average of 12 or more games.

USBC Rule 319a will apply in this tournament. Verification of averages must be attached to entry.

Handicap: Handicap will be 90% of 210.

Check-in: All Bowlers should be checked in no later than thirty(30) minutes prior to the start of their squad.

Squads: Squads will be at 1:00pm and 4:00pm on Saturday, Dec 14, 2019. Additional squad may be added on Sunday, Dec 15, 2019, only if All Squads fill.

Dress Code and Conduct: Shorts and skirts not shorter than fingertip length. No see-through shirts or clothing with rips or holes. No tank tops or midriff tops. T-shirts allowed if they do not advertise tobacco or alcohol products. No foul language or gestures. No hats or head cover unless for medical reason. Must have a signed note. No sagging pants. All decisions will be made by tournament manager. All decisions are final.

Scholarships: Scholarships & Certificates will be awarded for every 1 in 6 entries within each division based on handicap scores: 100% of Prize fund to be awarded for scholarships. No bowler shall be eligible for more than one scholarship. Should a tie exist for any of the scholarships, all bowlers involved in the tie will participate equally in the scholarship monies for the places involved.

A Special award will be awarded for high scratch series in each division. Special awards will be provided by the Greater OKC Area USBC Association.

Other Rules & Disputes: All rules not covered herein will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules & Regulation. All disputes and emergencies will be settled by the Greater OKC Area USBC Youth Committee and their decision is final unless appeal is made in writing to the Greater OKC Area USBC Association.
