# Greater Oklahoma City USBC Queen and King Tournament Rules

1. **Eligible Participants:** Any male or female adult USBC member in good standing that has paid for an Adult Membership through the Greater Oklahoma City Area USBC. Participants who are not Greater Oklahoma City Area USBC members may qualify prior to participation by paying the appropriate association member dues.
  2. **USBC Tournament Certification: #04150**
  3. **Divisions:** Female & Male
  4. **Entering Average:** This is a scratch tournament. No average verification is required.
  5. **Entries & Fees:** The entry fee for this tournament is \$100 with \$75 going to the prize fund, \$25 for lineage and expenses. Entries and fees are accepted on the USBC Online Tournament Portal on bowl.com. If unable to register online, contact the Greater Oklahoma City Area USBC office at (405) 943-5590 for assistance. Reserved online entries close at 12:00AM on Saturday, August 9, 2025. Entries received after this date will be assessed a \$20 administrative fee. Late entries must be received by 12:00 PM on Friday, August 15, 2025. NO WALK-INS WILL BE ALLOWED.
  6. **Late Arrivals:** Any bowler arriving after the scheduled start time of any round of the event must start in the frame being bowled when they arrive and will receive zero for each frame missed. NO SUBSTITUTES ARE ALLOWED.
1. **Tournament Format:**
    - a. **Round 1 - Qualifying Round** - Each bowler will bowl a total of (6) games. Initial lane assignments will be by random draw. There will be a maximum of (4) bowlers per lane. There will be 12 minutes of practice across all of the lanes. After each game, bowlers will move one pair to their right. All scratch scores will be totaled after the (6) games of qualifying.
    - b. **Round 2 - Semifinal Round** - The top (6) qualifying scores will advance to the match-play round. This unique format will assign bowlers to lanes as follows:

1	Position	1 vs 6	vs	3 vs 4	vs	5 vs 2
2	Position	5 vs 3	vs	1 vs 2	vs	4 vs 6
3	Position	4 vs 1	vs	5 vs 6	vs	2 vs 3

Each match won will be worth 30 bonus points (added to the bowler's score); ties are worth 15 points. The point totals for all (3) games will be totaled to determine who advances to Round 3. Lanes to be used will be decided by tournament management.

- c. **Round 3 - Championship Round** - The top (2) bowlers will bowl in a 2-out-of-3 game format on the centermost pair of the above six lanes. The winner will be crowned the Greater Oklahoma City Area USBC Queen/King.
- d. In the case of a tie in qualifying or position in Round 2, or any ties in Round 3, a head-to-head 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off will be held until a winner is determined.
- e. Each of the Round 2 participants who do not advance to Round 3 will cash.
